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Baldwin Park Dual-language Students Explore Culture in End-of-year Program

WHAT: Dual-language students from Baldwin Park Unified's Tracy Elementary School will provide an in-depth, layered showcase of their yearlong progress in language and cultural learning through an exploration of the life and musical works of iconic singer Juan Gabriel.

The program will include songs, dances and presentations as transitional kindergarten-through sixth-grade students demonstrate their growing knowledge of English and Spanish while highlighting Gabriel's impact on Latin America and Latin music.

DETAILS: Dual-language students will take their audience through Gabriel's early years in music and progress to the final stages of his career and life. Students will dance and sing to famous Gabriel pieces. Those with English as their primary language will speak in Spanish and native Spanish speakers will demonstrate their English language skills via presentations on the singer's life and influence on the arts.

Gabriel is famous for his music in Bolero and Mariachi styles. He was active from 1971 until his death in August 2016.
