Bassett Unified to Celebrate Flanner Early Childhood Development Center with Ribbon-cutting

Serving children from 18 months to 5 years old, Flanner is BUSD's seventh child development center. Flanner offers full-day and full-year programs, incorporating Head Start, Early Head Start, childcare, preschool, toddler and private programs to accommodate individual parenting needs within the Bassett Unified community.

The modern facilities feature new playground equipment, new carpet, shelves and cubbies, new instructional materials such as audio books, touch-and-feel books, painting tools and supplies and developmental learning materials, plus three interactive classrooms with playing and learning centers.

The ceremony will feature a Flanner CDC student reading a passage from the book "What Do You Do With An Idea?" Children's activities and appetizers will be available during a pre-event reception.
