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Lynwood Unified Students to Explore Augmented Reality with Google

WHAT: Lynwood Unified School District students will explore the wonders of dinosaurs and the moon landing through a presentation of the Google Expeditions Augmented Reality Pioneer Program.

Google representatives will visit Lugo and Abbott elementary schools to share technology that brings to life 3D objects, like a Michelangelo statue, on a smartphone or tablet so students may examine the object together.

Teachers will be trained on the program in the morning so they can lead expeditions in their classrooms. Potential lesson plans include: forces of nature, human muscular system, the ocean floor, phases of the moon, and World War I and II.

Lynwood Unified Superintendent Gudiel R. Crosthwaite will also attend.
