Fontana Unified's Second Annual Student Film Festival Set to Showcase District Talents and Programs

The award categories are separated by elementary, middle, high school, and alumni submissions. FUSD alumni who continued filmmaking after high school were also eligible to submit any format of a production they created post-graduation. Finalists for the Film Festival will be announced on April 24.
