# Monrovia High Drama Students to Perform 'King Lear' at A Noise Within

**WHAT:** Twenty-three drama students from Monrovia High School are partnering with Pasadena theater company A Noise Within to bring the students' rendition of William Shakespeare's "King Lear" to life.

Monrovia High students observed a professional production meeting and had the opportunity to sit in while A Noise Within conducted the first table read for its own "King Lear" production.

Monrovia High students will be able to use A Noise Within's "King Lear" set and stage in Pasadena when they perform their own take on the classical play.

This is the first time A Noise Within has partnered with a high school theater group, establishing a relationship of training and mentorship, and providing an opportunity for students to perform on a professional stage.
