Safety Reminders

- Walk on sidewalks or paths when available; otherwise, walk on the shoulder, facing traffic.
- Stay alert. Don't be distracted by electronic devices that take your eyes (and ears) off the road.
- Never assume drivers see you. Make eye contact with drivers as they approach.
- Be predictable. Cross streets at crosswalks or intersections when possible.
- If a crosswalk or intersection is not available, locate a well-lit area, wait for a gap in traffic that allows you enough time to cross safely and continue to watch for traffic as you cross.
- Be visible. Wear bright colors during the day and reflective materials or use a flashlight at night.
