Baldwin Park Unified Elementary School to Receive \$5,000 Grant

WHAT: Pleasant View Elementary School will celebrate receiving a 2017 Barona Education Grant, which brings the school \$5,000 for improving student achievement and creating immersive educational settings through computer and video production technology.

Assemblywoman Blanca Rubio, who chose Pleasant View for the grant, will present the award to Principal Linda Heredia.

DETAILS: Pleasant View will use the grant to buy four iPad Pro tablets, two tripods and two green screens to offer enhanced digital lessons and projects in fifth- and sixth-grade classrooms. The school plans to create an after-school broadcast journalism club, where students can report on events similar to a television newsroom.

The Barona Education Grant is an annual award from the Barona Band of Mission Indians, given to promote academic improvement in California schools. To be considered for the grant, a school must be endorsed by a state executive office holder, senator or assembly member.
