Baldwin Park Voters Select New, Returning Board Members

BALDWIN PARK – Baldwin Park voters on Nov. 4 re-elected Board of Education President Christina Lucero and board member Santos Hernandez Jr., as well as returning 2017-18 board member Diana E. Miranda-Dzib.

Members of the board will be sworn in during a scheduled organizational meeting on Tuesday, Dec. 8. The meeting will be held virtually.

"On behalf of Baldwin Park Unified, I want to thank the Baldwin Park community for using their voices and exercising their right to vote," Superintendent Dr. Froilan Mendoza said.
