Our Lady Of Guadalupe Celebration Features An Outdoor Bilingual Community Play

Whittier, Calif. – To honor Our Lady of Guadalupe, Rose Hills Memorial Park will present "Juan Diego & the Beautiful Lady," a free, bilingual outdoor theater performance on Sunday, Dec. 4 at 1 p.m. The play is performed by students of the Theatre Rehearsal and Performance class from Rio Hondo College's Performing Arts Department, along with students from St. Marianne de Paredes Elementary School in Pico Rivera.

The event is free with viewing areas set up at Mission Hills Plaza at Rose Hills, 3888 Workman Mill Road, Whittier, CA 90601. The performance will move across several stages within Mission Hills and in the surrounding hillside. A replica image bestowed upon Rose Hills by the Archbishop of Mexico City, along with a stone from the original Basilica de Guadalupe built between 1531 and 1709, will be incorporated into this year's production.
