El Monte Union Teacher Honored for Outstanding Commitment to Student Excellence

EL MONTE – Mountain View High School (MVHS) English teacher and Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) Coordinator Coreen Pineda is fueled by her love for her students, working tirelessly every day to inspire them to achieve great things and have confidence in their abilities.

These qualities have earned Pineda recognition by the El Monte Promise Foundation, honoring her with the Roberto "Bobby" Salcedo Esperanza Award for Outstanding Educators, an annual award presented to educators who exemplify a commitment to students and education. Pineda received her award during the foundation's 20th annual Tamalada Gala on Dec. 7.

Pineda was celebrated during the event by her family, friends, colleagues and a select group of students from MVHS VISTA Academy who attended to record the festivities. MVHS Principal Jose Bañas and MVHS parent Maria Ramos praised Pineda for her impactful work and positive character.

"We sat on the Associated Student Body together in high school," Pineda said. "Years later, when he became my boss at Mountain View, I got to continue getting to know him better. He was incredibly inspirational and the kind of administrator who would walk across campus to get things done personally."

While Pineda attended MVHS, she was inspired by her teachers to pursue a career in education. She went on to major in English at California State Polytechnic University, Pomona and has been teaching at her alma mater for the past 23 years.

In her free time, Pineda said she enjoys spending time with her family and cheering on her sons in their various athletic endeavors.
