BALDWIN PARK – Baldwin Park Unified held its annual Board reorganization meeting and Oath of Office Ceremony on Dec. 13, recognizing returning Board of Education member Deanna Coronado Robles and newly elected member John Bernard de Leon.

Before the reorganization, outgoing Board President Betsabel Lara was celebrated for her four years of service and for helping lead the District over the course of the COVID-19 pandemic.

During the organizational meeting, the Board selected member Diana E. Miranda-Dzib to serve as Board President and Christina Lucero to serve as Clerk/Vice President. Also serving on the board is member Santos Hernandez, Jr.
