DETAILS: The new Covina High School Athletics and Aquatics Complex provides student-athletes with expanded opportunities to compete, practice, and succeed. The complex features new baseball and softball fields, track and field equipment, batting cages, futsal, volleyball, basketball, and pickleball courts, an Olympic-sized swimming pool, restrooms, a snack bar, and more.

The \$22 million project was funded through multiple sources, including Measure CC bond funds; a federal grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, sponsored by Congresswoman Grace Napolitano; and Community Redevelopment funds and Developer fees.
