El Monte High to Celebrate \$6.6 Million Stadium Renovation on March 20

WHAT: El Monte High School will hold a ribbon-cutting ceremony to celebrate \$6.6 million in renovations to its stadium – including a snack bar, restrooms and bleachers to seat more than 2,000 spectators – at 6 p.m. **Wednesday, March 20.**

Lion Stadium was renovated to increase seating capacity for spectators to enjoy a broad range of sports, including football, soccer, and track and field, as well as to celebrate student milestones, such as graduation.

The ceremony will feature remarks from El Monte Union Superintendent Dr. Edward Zuniga, Board of Trustees President David Diaz and El Monte High football player Abel Cueva.

Attendees are invited to enjoy a night rally in which students from winter and spring athletics will engage in friendly competition following the ceremony.

DETAILS: El Monte High broke ground on the bleacher renovation project in 2017. The site features new fencing, landscaping, a gate entrance and ticket booth. Seating includes a home stand for 1,173 guests, a stand for 824 visitors and additional seating for up to 100 guests. The project was funded by Measure D.
