Beginning with a blank canvas, Visual Art students sketched the design onto the choir walls, meticulously outlined and painted each element of the mural, and finally added a striking blue background upon completion.

"Before this project, I had not seen much spirit throughout the walls of our campus but, I believe with having our iconic blue as the backdrop and the rich history of our Lion incorporated into the mural it will shine a bright light onto our past and future triumphs," EMHS Art Club president and junior Juan Torres said. "I also have a niece and nephew and if they decide to come to El Monte and join band or pick up art, I hope they can one day look at this mural and remember me and the high school experiences I share with them and make incredible ones of their own."

Over the years, a total of 70 students contributed to the realization of the mural project and united together to create a memorable experience shaped by their shared goals for the future.
