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Pomona Learning Expo Opens a Universe of Exploration

Event exposes Pomona Unified students to arts, science and literacy

WHAT: The eighth annual Ross/McCracken Learning Expo will offer hands-on exploration of arts, science and literacy for more than 2,000 children from across the region. Features include a massive sky dome planetarium, an earth dome, live animals, a chance to build skeletons from owl pellets and demonstration of a cow-eye dissection. The free event includes performances by mariachi group Luz de la Luna, Aztec dance troupe Danzantes del Sol and the Lincoln Elementary folklorico dancers.
