San Ysidro School District Hosts Ribbon-Cutting of Synthetic Turf Field

WHAT: The San Ysidro School District will host a ribbon-cutting ceremony to celebrate the opening of Sunset Elementary School's new synthetic grass play field, which provides students with a safe, contemporary surface to exercise and play sports.

The ribbon-cutting ceremony will be hosted on the field and will feature comments from District and school officials, in addition to a student performance and student speaker from Sunset Elementary School.

WHY: Sunset Elementary School's new field is a synthetic turf made of recycled materials and replaces Sunset's former rubberized play surface, which had deteriorated due to age and required replacement. The field renovation is in line with the District's commitment to improving and modernizing existing SYSD facilities to support student learning and achievement.

The field was donated and installed by local San Diego construction company Manzana Energy. The donation was approved via resolution by the San Ysidro School District Board of Education in December.

The 61,200-square-foot field is valued at \$1 million and is expected to last 20 years.
